### **SPECIAL ACTIVITIES**

#### **Host Family Dinner:**

The traditional Host Family Dinner has been an important IH RTP's social activity since 1994. This event is a unique occasion for participants to enjoy an evening of Canadian hospitality and experience an enriching intercultural exchange.

#### **International Evening:**

The International Evening is a special dinner event with a catered international menu followed by performances by participants and staff. You are encouraged to bring with you musical instruments, traditional clothing, recorded music and any other symbolic objects representative of your country's traditions. Be prepared to entertain and be entertained!

#### **Visit to Ottawa:**

A one-day trip to Ottawa, Canada's capital, will be organized. The cost of this activity is approximately \$35 Canadian for those who wish to participate.

#### **Visit to the Montreal Holocaust Memorial Museum:**

For the last 6 years, Equitas has organized an optional weekend day trip to the Museum. This Museum is an excellent example of a human rights education tool to educate about the genocide in Europe during World War II as well as to sensitize the public to questions of human rights and moral responsibility. After a guided tour of the museum, participants will have the opportunity to speak with Holocaust survivors living in Montreal. Participants taking part in this activity will also attend a briefing session to prepare for the visit and a debriefing session afterwards to discuss the experience.

#### **RAP sessions:**

Participants will be invited to participate in regional or thematic meetings with Equitas staff to obtain more information about Equitas' activities and to network with other participants.
